Faff was within projected boundaries, with extra fire blanket training at the end for stewards, tech, group techs, and some torchies was good (done with permission from the park). TW notes that the park is much more relaxed about us. Ranger team has been very pleased with us. Citizen Ticket devices will be a bit limited (only 3), will be using some android phones to supplement this. All ticket holders being directed to the parliament end, though there are ticket processing capabilities at duck pond entrance. SS 7.2. Court SS - check in with Blues about how Court are faring.
